...raise £250 for Trinity Hospice

Founded in 1891 as England's first hospice, Trinity continues to be an innovative and influential centre for end of life care.

Trinity is the local hospice for the 750,000 people living in our central and south west London catchment area – each year 10,000 people in this community will discover that they have a terminal illness.

Last year, our community nurses cared for 3,500 people in their own homes, and we cared for more than 400 people on our wards. All our services are provided free of charge.

Our priority is to expand our community care services so that more people are able to die in their own home or care home, which is where most people would prefer to be.

People are often surprised to discover that we are a charity and that we receive just 36% of our income from the NHS. This means that we must raise more than £5 million each year to continue providing the specialist care our community relies on.

£125 – Karaoke, quiz or darts night at your local pub/social club

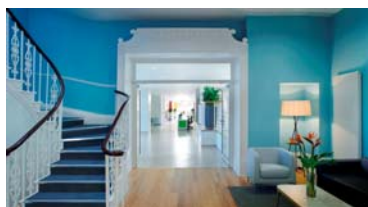
AND THEN...

£125 - Matched giving – most non government/charity employers will have a matched giving scheme which offers their employees a £1 for £1 donation of up to £500. The great thing is companies receive tax deductions on their charity donations, so it saves them money and makes them look really good!
